

2023 Maple Hill Invitational presented by Thought Space Athletics

Event Outline

Teams

- Submit roster of 4-6 players, including PDGA number.
 - Players will be seeded on the team by PDGA rating. Unrated players are seeded lower.
 - Teams will be seeded by average rating of top four players on the team.
 - Pairings each round will be made using the Swiss system.

Match Procedure

- 20 minutes before your doubles tee time, the team round roster must be designated.
 - Of these four, the highest seeded player plays in the first singles game.
 - The next highest player plays in the second singles game.
 - The lower two play the doubles game.
 - This is repeated each round.
- All games are matchplay.
- All games are 18 holes. If a game is tied after 18 holes, it is halved.

Match Results

- The team that wins two or more games wins the match.
- If the match is tied 1.5 to 1.5, the match is halved.
- The team that wins the most matches is the national champion.
- The regional team that wins the most matches is the regional champion.
- Tiebreakers, listed in order
 - Head to head results if all tied teams have played each other
 - Game points (wins are one point, ties are a half)
 - Weighted match points
 - Weighted game points
